You've Got to be Kidding!

1. Must be 12 years old or older. All contestants enter at their own risk. Pilot Grove FFA, Cooper County 4-H and Cooper County Fair are not responsible for accidents. All contestants must sign a release form and individuals under 18 must have parental signature.
2. Three (3) people per team. One must be of the opposite sex.
3. Three (3) articles of clothing must be put on pig in order.
 1. Bra
 2. Panties
 3. ShirtClothing will be provided.
4. Each team member must put on an article of clothing. Pig must be held by at least 2 different members.
5. Pig will be release into pen first. Team members must go to three different corners before time begins.
6. Flagman will signal with flag up for time to begin.
7. When team is fully dressed they must signal to flagman with hands up. When flag drops, time will stop.
8. Head of pig must not be held down and must be kept out of mud. Judges will disqualify team if head is down or under mud.
9. No mud throwing.
10. All decisions of judges will be final.

Hose and water will be furnished for clean up.
